JUNIOR MEMBER CODE OF CONDUCT:

- I will always play by the rules.
- I will control my temper.
- I will work equally hard for myself and my team.
- I will be a good sport and applaud all good plays whether they are made by my team or the opposition.
- I will treat all players in my sport as I like to be treated.
- I will cooperate with my coach, teammates and opponents.
- I will display modesty in victory and graciousness in defeat.
- I will participate for my own enjoyment and benefit, not just to please parents, supporters and coaches.
- I will respect the rights, dignity and worth of all participants regardless of their gender, ability, cultural background or religion.
- I will thank the opposition and officials at the end of the game.
- I will not bully or take unfair advantage of another competitor, argue with officials.
- I will not damage, neglect or fail to properly care for club property or facilities.

COACH AND/OR TEAM MANAGER CODE OF CONDUCT:

- I will be reasonable in demands on my players' time, energy, and enthusiasm.
- I will operate within the rules and spirit of cricket and teach players to do the same.
- I will ensure that each player in my team has a positive experience.
- I will ensure that team members receive equal attention and opportunities.
- I will ensure that equipment and facilities are safe and are appropriate to the age and ability of my team.
- I will display self control, respect, and professionalism to all involved with the sport including opponents, umpires, coaches, officials, administrators, the media, parents, and spectators and teach players to do the same.
- I will show concern and caution towards sick and injured players and follow the advice of a physician when determining whether an injured player is ready to recommence training or competition.
- I will obtain appropriate cricket coaching and/or team management qualifications.
- I will keep up to date with the latest cricket coaching practices and principles of growth and development of young players.
- I will respect the rights, dignity and worth of all people involved in the game, regardless of their gender, ability or cultural background.
- I will not ridicule or shout at players for making mistakes or for not winning.
- I will not damage, neglect, or fail to properly care for club property or facilities.
- I will not arrive at playing venues intoxicated, or drink alcohol at matches.
- I will not allow the unlawful supply of alcohol at training, games, or club functions.
- I will not use offensive language at training, games, or club functions.
- I will not harass club or opposition players, officials, spectators or other coaches.

PARENT/GUARDIAN CODE OF CONDUCT:

- I will encourage all Junior members to play within the rules of spirit of the game.
- I will respect the decisions of officials and coaches.
- I will teach junior members to respect the efforts of their opponents, applaud good plays and performances by both the club's and opposition players.
- I will give positive comments that motivate and encourage continued effort, support junior members efforts and performance.
- I will thank coaches, officials and other volunteers who give up their time to allow junior members to participate in cricket and cricket related events at the club.
- I will provide help when asked by a coach or official, respect the rights, dignity and worth of all people involved in the game, regardless of their gender, ability or cultural background.
- I will not pressure junior members in any way.
- I will not arrive at the venue intoxicated, or drink alcohol at junior matches.
- I will not use offensive language, or harass players, coaches, officials, or other spectators.
- I will not criticise or ridicule my child's or other children's performance at or after the game.

BWCUCC Media Consent Policy:

I consent to being photographed or filmed by bwucc. I give my consent to bwucc to photograph or film the children legally under my care and nominated as members of the club in this registration form. I understand photographs and/or video may be used by the club, and club partners, for promotional purposes of any kind at any time in the future. Images may be cropped, altered, or reproduced in any way and may be combined with other works or text. I release the club and the club's partners from any claims and demands in connection with the photographs and/or film.

BWCUCC Subscriptions Payment Policy:

(A) Where any member is unable to play throughout the full season for any reason, including the late enrolment with the club during a season in progress, the Executive Committee may set a reduced amount of the subscription level for that member and, where necessary, refund any discounted amount for the full subscription amount previously paid.

(B) The full subscription of every playing member or social member (not being a new member elected during the season) shall become due and payable on the 1st October of each new season.

(C) Where the subscription of any playing member (not being a new member enrolling during the course of the season) remains unpaid after 30th November in that season that member may be suspended forthwith from participation in all club activities and from the use and enjoyment of club facilities until such time as the subscription is paid – unless arrangement for instalment payments have been agreed to by the executive committee.

(D) Where the subscription of any playing member suspended pursuant to paragraph (c) of this rule remains unpaid after the 31st January following the suspension by the Executive Committee may forthwith or at any time in the future remove the name of that member from the roll of members and that member shall therefore cease to be entitled to any of the privileges of membership without however being released from his / her liability for the arrears of subscriptions due owing unless arrangements for instalment payments have been agreed to by the Executive Committee.

(E) Every new member enrolling or registering during the season shall become due and payable immediately upon his / her enrolment or registration and the amount of such subscription shall be at the discretion of the Executive Committee.

(F) Where the subscription of any new member enrolling or registering during the season remains unpaid after the 30th day of November during the season remains unpaid after the 30th day of November, or one month from the date of his/her enrolling or registering, whichever is later, that member may be suspended forthwith from participation in all club activities and the use and enjoyment of club facilities until such time as his / her subscription is paid unless arrangements for instalment payments have been agreed to by the Executive Committee.

(G) Where the subscription of any new member enrolling or registering during the season remains unpaid after the 31st January in the season of his / her enrolling or registering or one month from the date of his / her enrolling or registering the Executive Committee may forthwith or at any time in the future remove the name of that member from the roll of members and that member shall therefore cease absolutely to be entitled to any of the privileges of membership without however being released from his/her liability for the arrears of subscriptions due owing unless arrangements for instalment payments have been agreed to by the Executive Committee.

(H) A Member's subscription will be in default if their subscription is unpaid, in full or in part, after the last playing Saturday of the season, and will remain in default until all amounts owing have been paid in full, such amount being the subscription level originally applicable, together with any reasonable debt collection charges which, at the Executive Committee's discretion, are incurred by the Club.
